



EOCS Rules

Revised 12/3/2004

SECTION I - DIVISIONS

A. OVERALL CHAMPIONSHIP

1. Categories

- a. Concours
- b. Rallye
- c. Speed

2. Qualifications

- a. Individual **MUST** enter one (1) event in each category.
- b. Individual **MUST** use the same Corvette and stay in the same class for Concours and Speed events.
- c. Individual **May** use any Corvette for Rallye.

3. Awards

- a. First Place, Second Place, and Third Place overall for both Men and Ladies.
- b. The best four (4) out of five (5) events in each category determines the winner.

B. CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP

1. Categories

- a. Concours

- a. **Individual must enter four (4) events in a Category.**
 - b. **Individual must use the same Corvette and stay in the same class for Concours and Speed events.**
 - c. **Individual may use any Corvette for Rallye.**
- 3. Awards**
- a. **First Place for both Men and Ladies in the following Categories:**
 - (1) **Concours - Concours Prepared**
 - (2) **Concours - Street/Show**
 - (3) **Concours - Wash and Show**
 - (4) **Concours - Race Prepared**
 - (5) **Concours - Custom**
 - (6) **Concours - Modified**
 - (7) **Speed - Group I - pre 1984**
 - (8) **Speed - Group I – 1984 & up**
 - (9) **Speed - Group IS – pre 1984**
 - (10) **Speed - Group IS - 1984 & up**
 - (11) **Speed - Group II – pre 1984**
 - (12) **Speed – Group II – 1984 & up**
 - (13) **Speed - Group III**
 - b. **First and Second Places for both Driver and Navigator in the Rallye Category.**
 - c. **The best four (4) out of five (5) events in each Category determine the winner.**

SECTION II - EVENTS

A. SCHEDULING

- 1. **The scheduling months are March through November. Dates will be selected at the December Regional Business Meeting.**
 - a. **A total of five (5) events in each Category.**
 - b. **It is suggested that events in the same Category be scheduled three (3) weeks apart within the same month.**
 - c. **One (1) event per weekend.**

C. FLYERS

- 1. Must be completed and mailed according to the NCCC rules.**
 - a. One (1) copy is mailed directly to the Championship Series Director.**
- 2. Must CLEARLY display "East Ohio Championship Series" and for multiple event days, must identify which sanctioned event is the East Ohio Championship Series Event.**
 - a. Failure to do so results in a \$5.00 fine payable to the East Ohio Region.**
 - b. Corrected flyers must be mailed to each East Ohio Region Club Governor and East Ohio Championship Series Director within thirty (30) days prior to the event.**

D. RESULTS

- 1. Must be completed according to NCCC rules and the following:**
 - a. Color, Year, and License Plate Number of each car must be noted on all result sheets, except for Rallye.**
 - b. Driver and Navigator must be noted on result sheets for Rallye.**
- 2. Must be mailed to East Ohio Championship Series Director within fifteen (15) days following the event.**
 - a. Failure to do so will result in a \$5.00 fine payable to the East Ohio Region.**
 - b. If results are corrected, a copy of the corrected results and any additional entrant fees (as defined in D.3) must be mailed to the East Ohio Championship Series Director.**
- 3. A check in the amount of \$1.50 per entrant, both NCCC and non-NCCC, must accompany all result sheets sent to the East Ohio Championship Series Director, payable to the East Ohio Region.**

E. CANCELLATIONS

- 1. The host club must notify the Championship Series Director by phone as soon as possible.**
- 2. The Regional Board of Governors must approve rescheduling of events.**

SECTION III - POINTS

- A. Points will be awarded for actual competition only.**
 - 1. There are no chairperson(s), worker, host, or travel points.**
 - 2. Any NCCC Member may earn points.**
 - 3. Chairman and Co-Chairman of Concours and Speed events have the option to participate in the event.**
 - 4. Points for FTD remain at "9".**

- B. In Concours and Speed events, points cannot be transferred from one division to another. In Rallye events, points cannot be transferred between the two (2) divisions of Driver and Navigator.**

- C. The Championship Series Director will distribute a points report at each Regional Meeting, commencing at the first Regional Meeting following the first Championship Series event.**
 - 1. All individuals must be listed on the "Individual Championship Standings" report. Only those individuals who qualify for OVERALL championship will be listed on the "Overall Championship Standings" report.**

- D. Individual points also accumulate toward overall club championship points.**
 - 1. Each individual's points will be added to his/her Club's total.**

- E. Ties**
 - 1. Individual Championship - For Speed and Rally events, the fifth event will be used to break a tie by using the points earned at that event. For Concours, the best four (4) out of five (5) percentages from the Concours events will be used. To avoid year-end ties, it is recommended that entrants be judged in Concours events.**
 - 2. Overall Championship - The fifth events will be used to break a tie by using the points earned at those events. If a tie still exists, the best four (4) out of five (5) percentages from the Concours events will be used. To avoid year-end ties, it is recommended that entrants be judged in Concours events.**
 - 2. If unable to break a tie, awards will be given to both parties.**

SECTION IV - RULES

- A. No changes will be made during the competition year except for safety.**
- B. Proposed changes are to be submitted and discussed at the October Regional Meeting.**
 - 1. Proposed changes will be voted on at the December Regional Meeting.**
